



Are you looking for an affordable Country Club Golf and Social Experience? If so, Sandy Run Country Club offers the very best value for a family-oriented Private Golf Club in the Delaware Valley.

Sandy Run CC has a long standing history dating back to 1923 when it was originally chartered as the Edgehill Golf Club.

The golf architect for the course was J Franklin Meehan, who was a well-known Philadelphia area Landscape Architect who also designed the nearby North Hills Country Club.

Its rolling well manicured topography provides a perfect setting for a challenging but fair round of golf for golfers at every skill level.

The course is beautifully landscaped and situated on 115 acres in Springfield Township, Montgomery County, just outside of historic Fort Washington.

The par 72 course plays between 6625 yards (Blue Tees) to 5716 yards (Red Tees) with 3 par 5 and 3 par 3 holes.

Club Enhancement Goals

The club is committed to an ongoing capital improvement program designed to continually enhance both the golf course and clubhouse.

Types of Membership

Full Members - Family and Single

Enjoy all the golf and clubhouse privileges that Sandy Run CC has to offer and become a Full Member. Full Members have golf and practice facility privileges as well as access to all clubhouse amenities and social events. Clubhouse amenities include a full service bar and dining

room, a grill room with shuffle board table, pool table, card tables and TVs, a banquet room for social events, a fitness center, and large outdoor patio overlooking the 10th and 18th holes. Full Members are entitled to vote in club elections for the Board of Governors and on major issues involving the club's policies, by-laws and financial management. Under a Family Membership a member's spouse and children up to age 22 also have golf privileges.

Accelerated Members

Help keep your upfront costs low by becoming an Accelerated Member. The only difference between a Full Member and an Accelerated Member is that the Accelerated Member does not have voting privileges. This category of Members was created to reduce the initial cost to a new member by spreading the "initiation fee" over an extended 10 year period of time. Upon payment of the entire initiation fee the member becomes a Full Member.

Progressive Members

Sandy Run welcomes younger members over the age of 21. To attract these younger members, the club created this category of golfers who are 40 years and younger. To make the membership affordable, Progressive Members are permitted to defer any initiation fee payments until they reach the age of 41. New members who are 35 years and younger also have the benefit of a reduced annual dues schedule. Progressive Members also have all the golf and clubhouse privileges as a Full or Accelerated Member.

House Members

If you are busy working and raising a family, but want to get out to play golf occasionally and have access to the clubhouse amenities, a House Membership might be right for you. House Members have golf privileges limited to Wednesdays and Fridays and after 2 PM on the weekends during the golf season and a few designated tournaments. They also have full access to all Clubhouse amenities.

Social Members

For those who don't golf but want to enjoy the amenities and camaraderie afforded by a friendly private country club, consider becoming a Social Member. A Social Member has all of the clubhouse privileges afforded to all other members.

If you do not know a current member, the membership committee conducts periodic meet and greet sessions as part of an interviewing process for new applicants.
